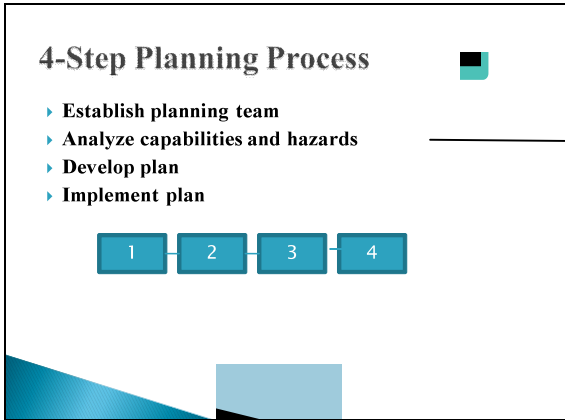


Emergency Management

Emergency Management: Process of preparing for, mitigating, responding to and recovering from an emergency.



Gather information about current capabilities and possible hazards and emergencies

Conduct vulnerability analysis to determine facility's capabilities for handling emergencies

Vulnerability Analysis:

The probability and potential impact of an emergency

Plan Components

- ▶ Executive summary
- ▶ Emergency management elements
- ▶ Emergency response procedures
- ▶ Support documents

Emergency Management Elements

This section of the plan briefly describes facility's approach to core elements of emergency management:

- **Direction and control**
- **Communications**
- **Life safety**
- **Property protection**
- **Community outreach**
- **Recovery and restoration**
- **Administration and logistics**

Integrate the Plan into Company Operations

- ▶ Emergency planning must become part of corporate culture
- ▶ Look for opportunities to:
 - Build awareness
 - Educate and train personnel
 - Test procedures
 - Involve all levels of management, all departments and the community in planning process
 - Make emergency management part of what personnel do on day-to-day basis
