<u>OSHA 2055: Cranes for Construction</u>	21-23 March 2023 - Online		This course is designed to benefit employers, general contractors, subcontractors, property owners and safety personnel who need to understand OSHA's Rule on Cranes and Derricks in Construction, CFR 29 1926 Subpart CC and how to work safely around cranes.

Some positions could include shipyard supervisor, port engineer, ship repair supervisor or manager, facilities manager, port maintenance technician, safety technician, safety managers, shipyard or marine terminal managers, electrical managers, longshoreman, longshoreman managers/supervisors, and port safety.
